To receive Rocky boots, a Veteran must have punches from all 6 areas on their wristband.

Look for signs with these symbols in these areas: **Legal Aid Mini Job Fair, Housing, Academic, Provider, and VA Medical**

Remember, you do not have to use the services in these areas, but you must have all 6 punches in your wristband to receive Rocky boots.

Also, you don't have to get boots.

Enter the Clothing Area with all 6 punches to get boots.

You can get a Yellow reentry wristband at the Parking Ticket table.
